## Workshop Details:

#### "Wilde Impressions" - An Introduction to botanical Printmaking

In introduction to Botanical Printmaking on paper, I teach some of my printmaking techniques using physical plant specimens and a home-made gelatine plate. I share tips on inks and the recipe to make your own gelatine plate. Inks and paper will be supplied. If you'd like to print on fabric, please bring your own. Fine cotton suits these techniques best. Includes materials (not fabric), and refreshments.

#### "Mix and Match" - Print, collage, paint

We'll do some quick botanical prints on paper with rollers and brayers using acrylic paint. I'll work through how I approach collaging some of them together and what mediums I use and why. We'll then add paint to pull some areas forward and push other areas back. I'll also demonstrate how I stitch on paper with a sewing machine. We may even use coloured pencils! If you would like to bring some prints that you have done previously, please do. Includes materials, refreshments and a light lunch.

#### "Off the beaten track" - Walk, draw, collage, paint, hand stitch

Bring your walking shoes for this one! If the weather permits\*, we'll go for a gentle walk in the fynbos where we'll do some simple mark making inspired by what we see. Back at the studio we'll glue and stitch together a painting surface of fabric and paper. Drawing on the inspiration gathered earlier, you will make an abstract recording of our walk with pencils, pens, paint etc. This is a jam packed workshop so will run a little longer than most. \*If the weather doesn't play ball, we'll go for an imaginary walk!

Includes materials, refreshments and a light lunch.
